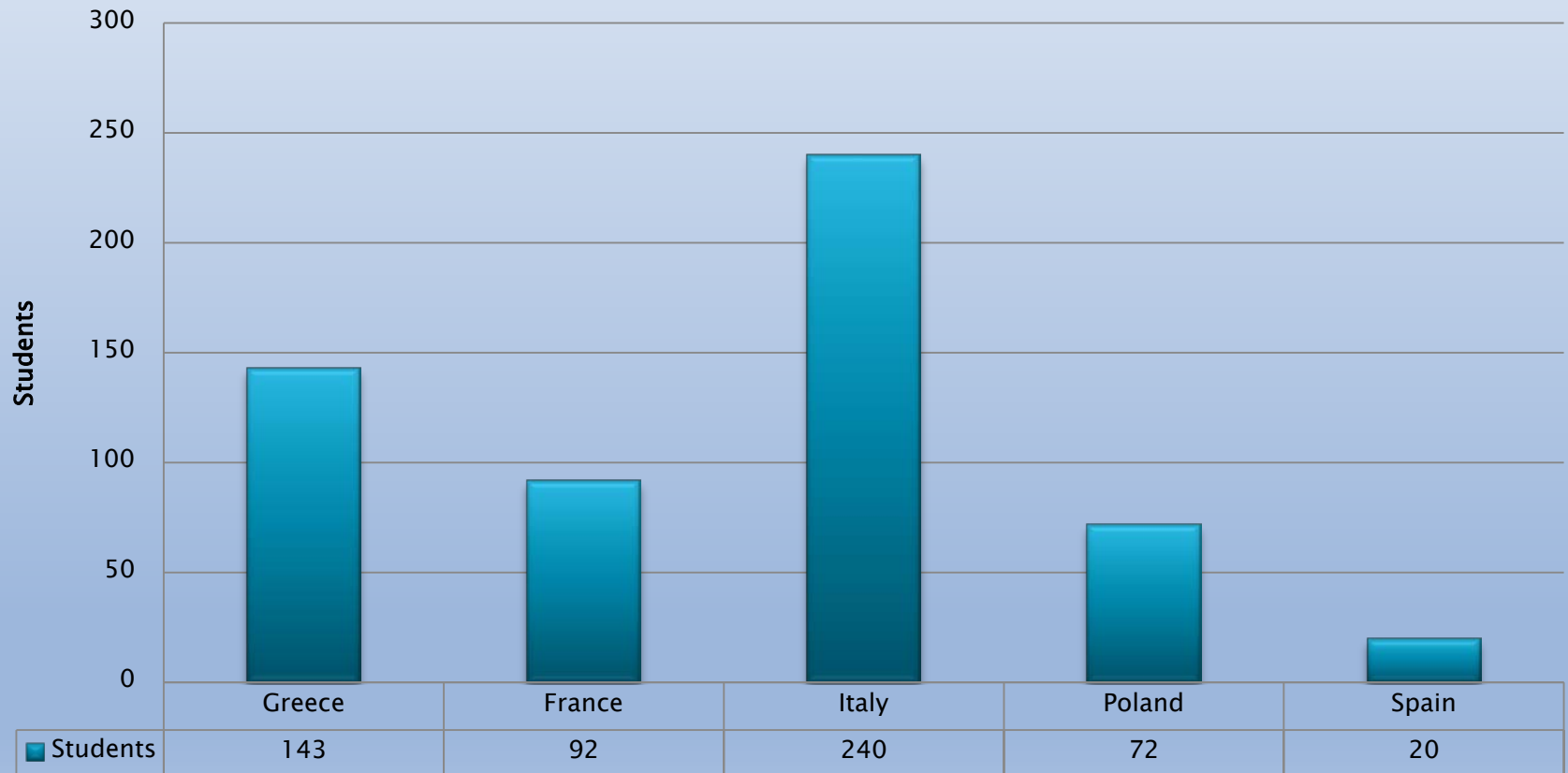

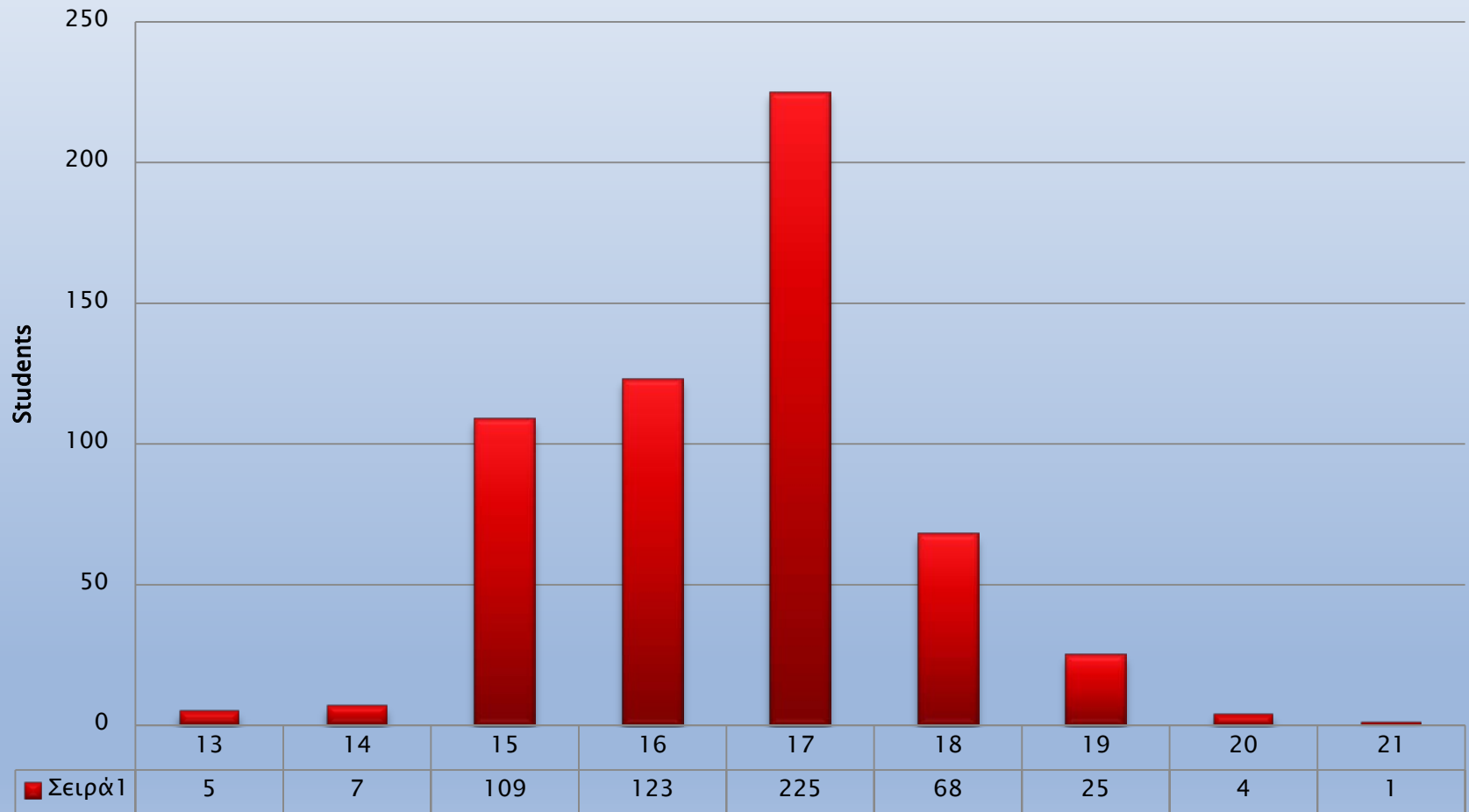

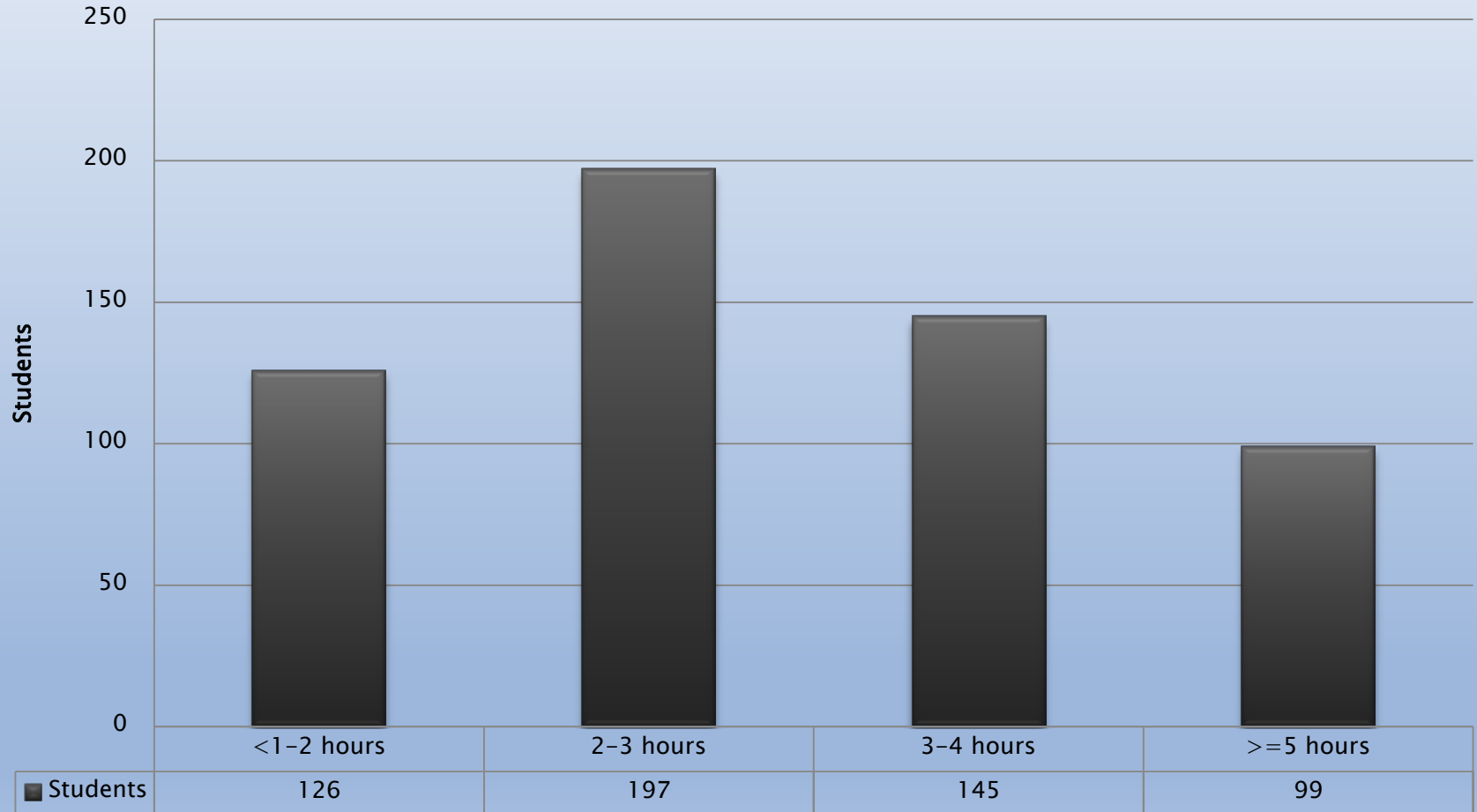

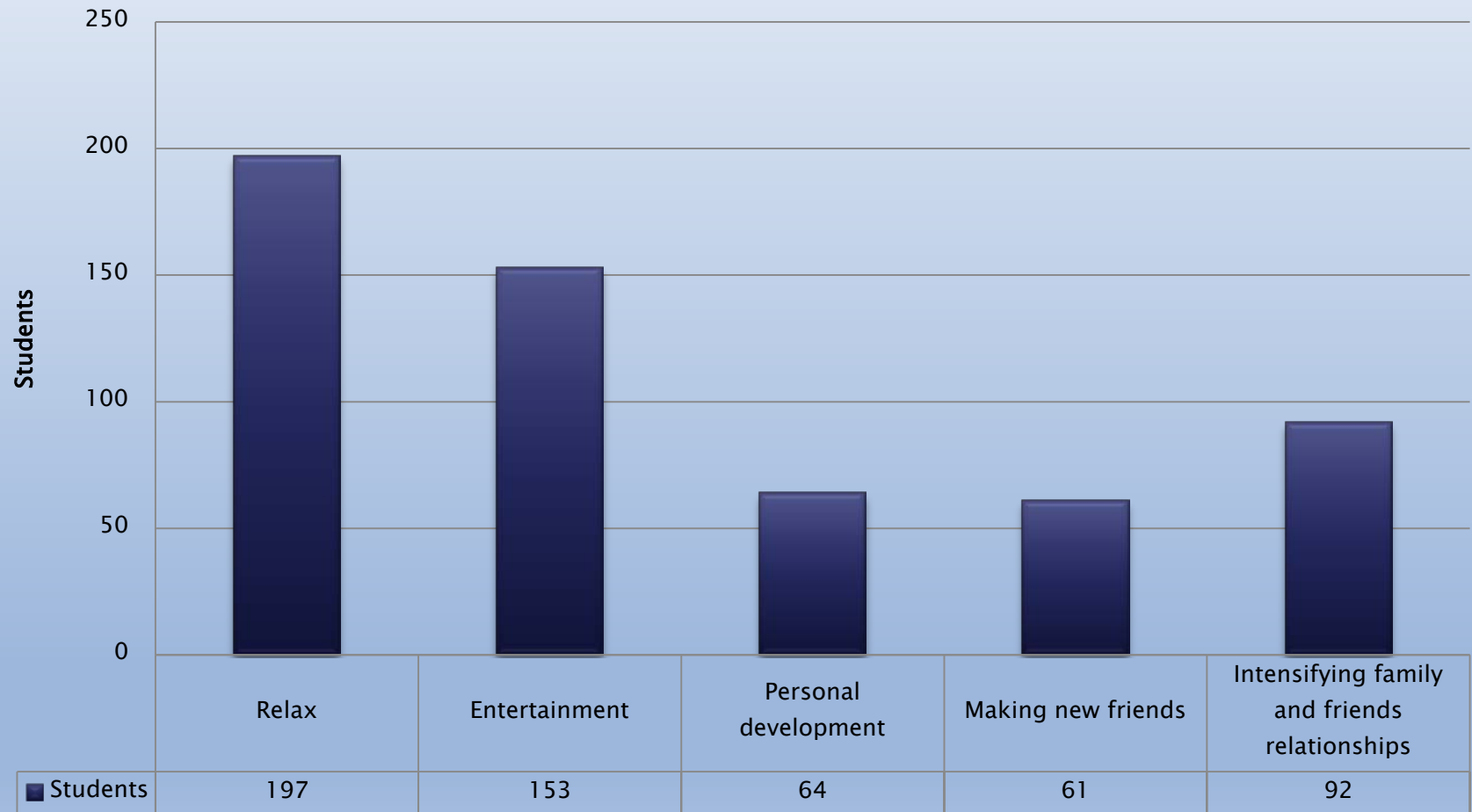
A5 - How much free time do you have at the weekend?



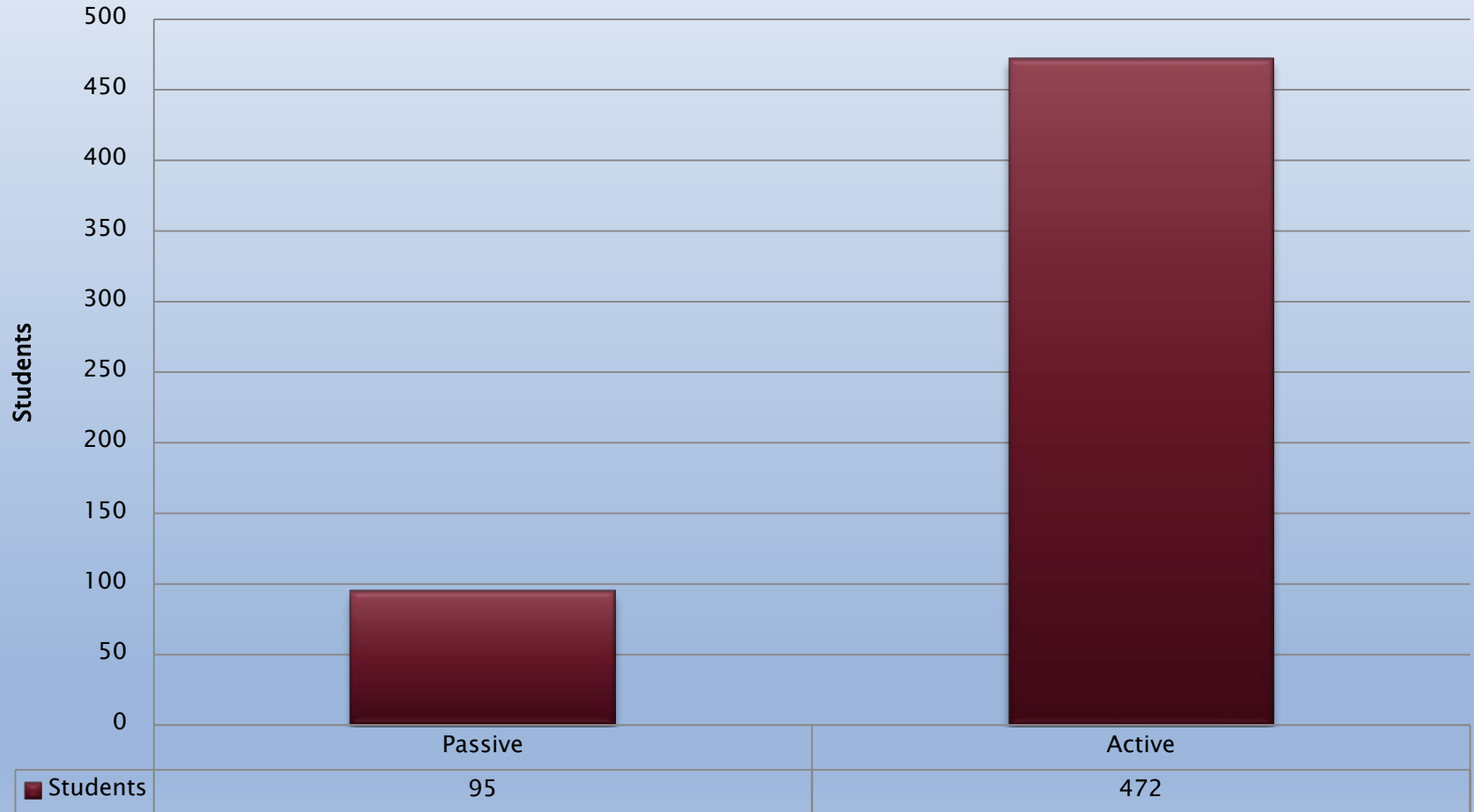

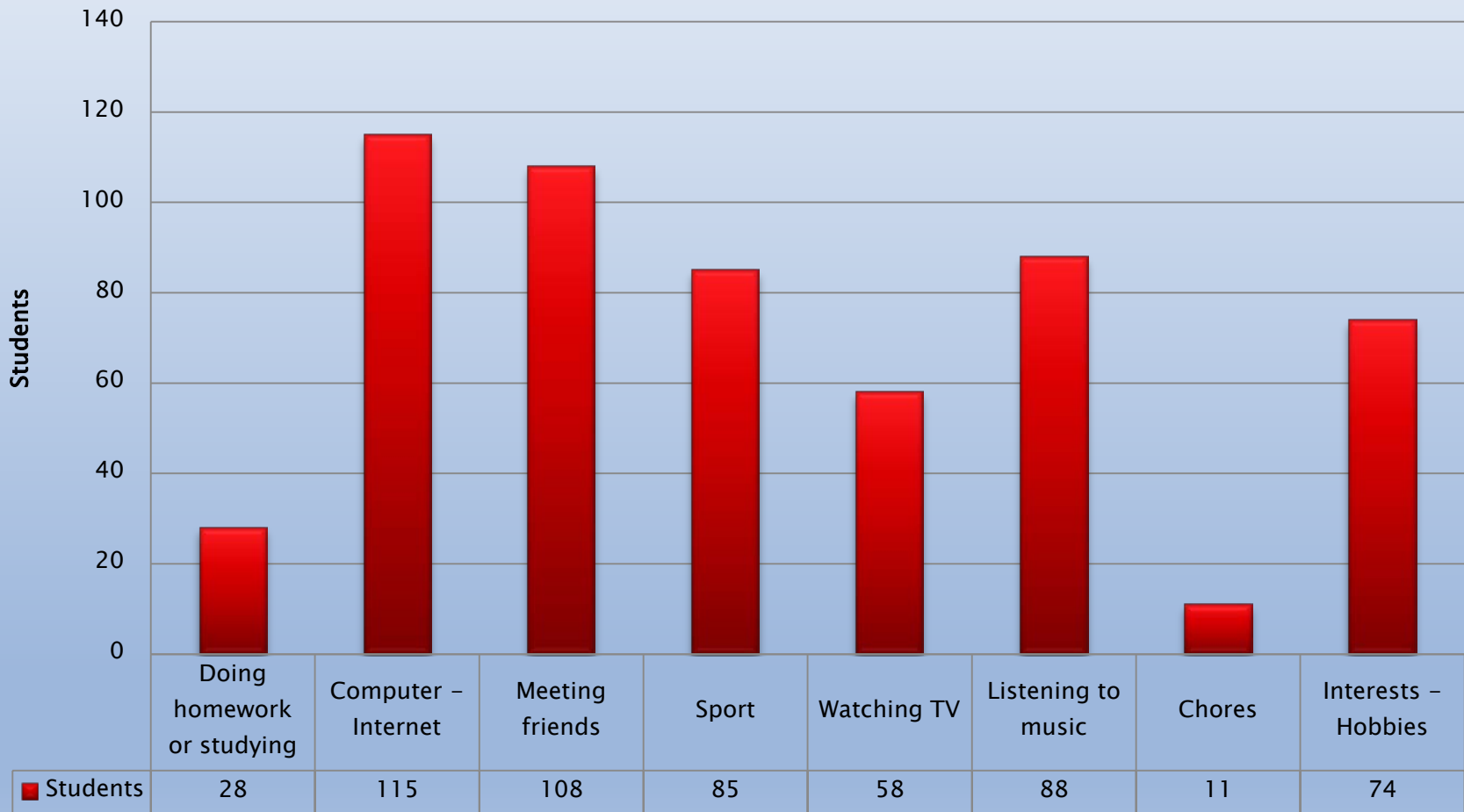

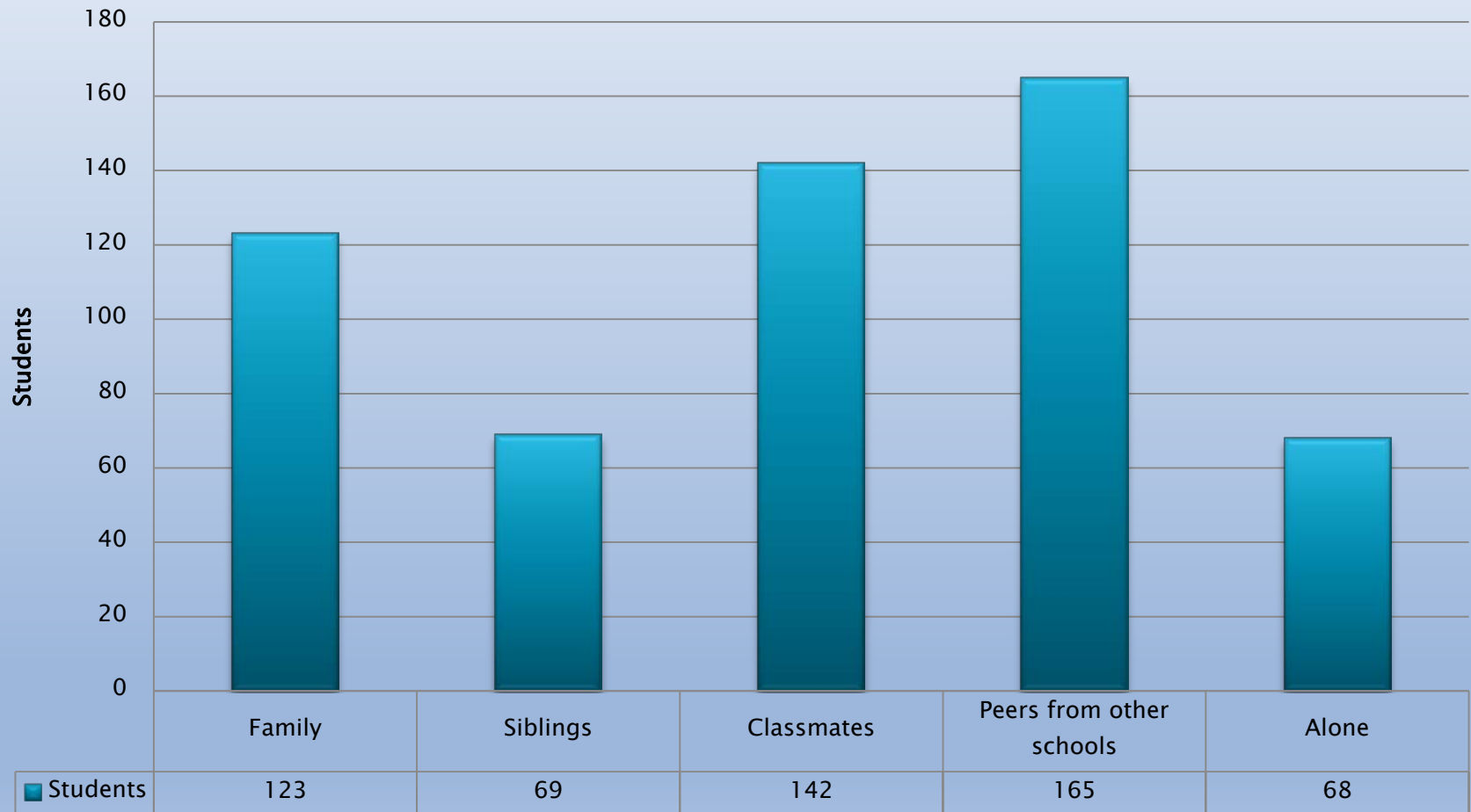

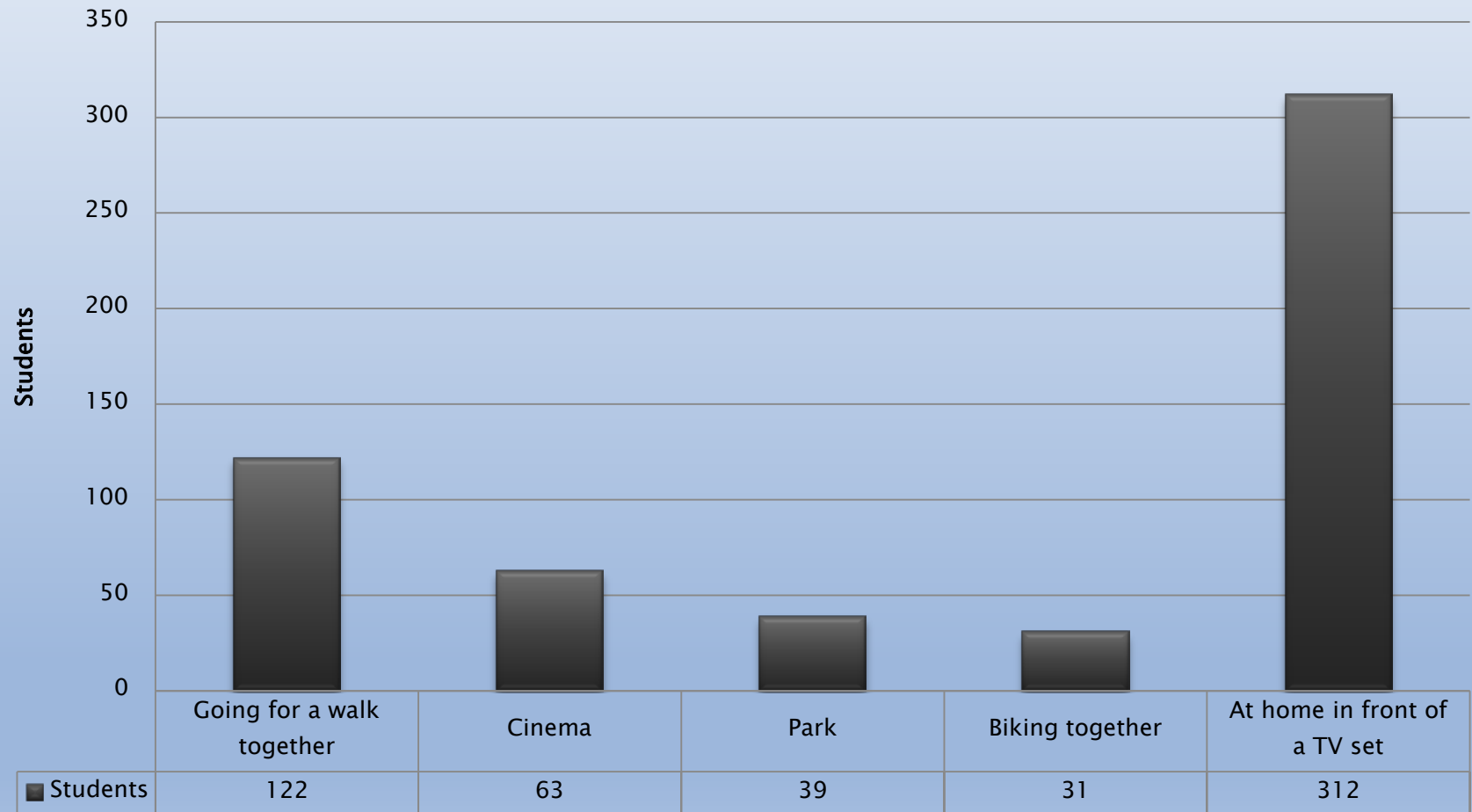

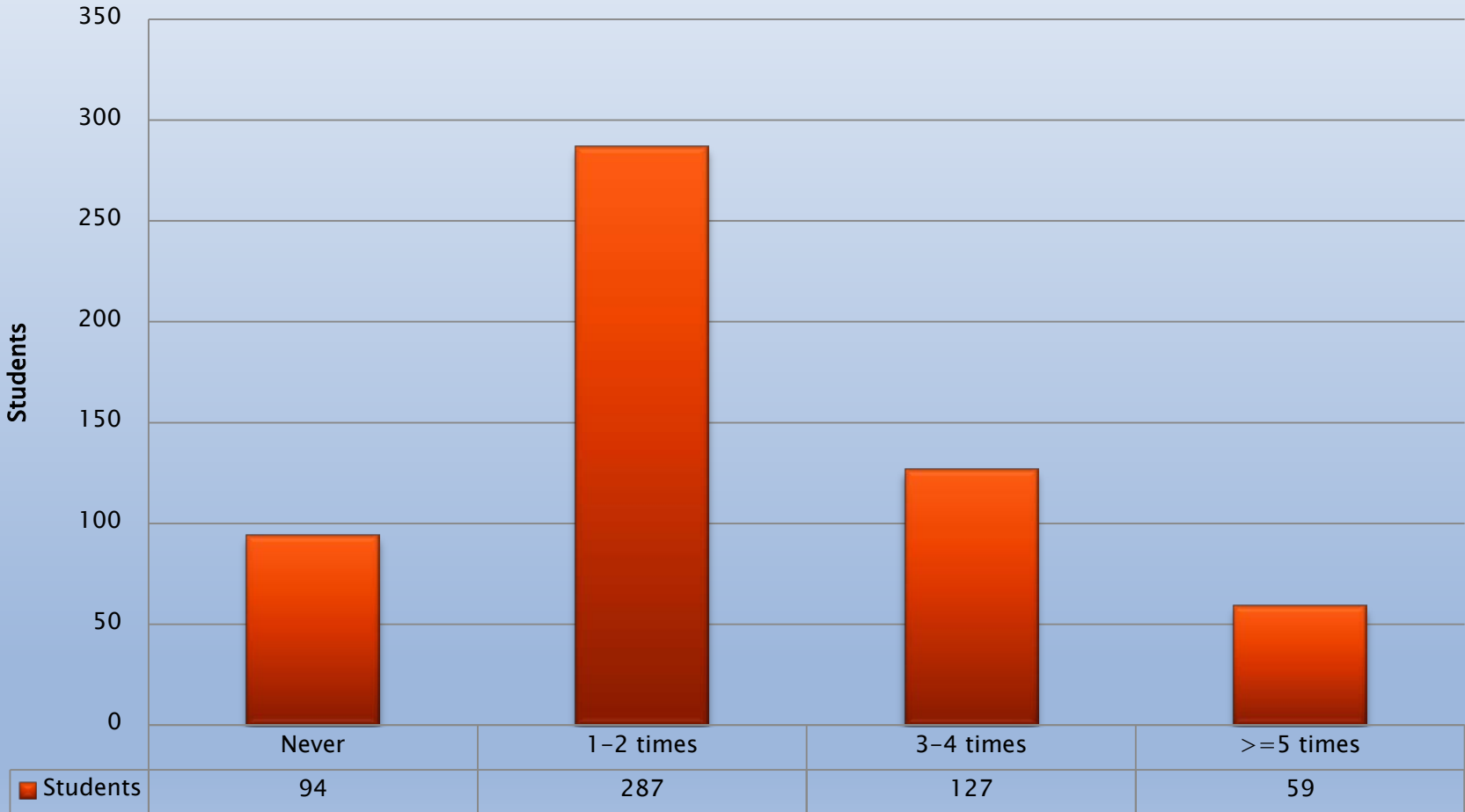

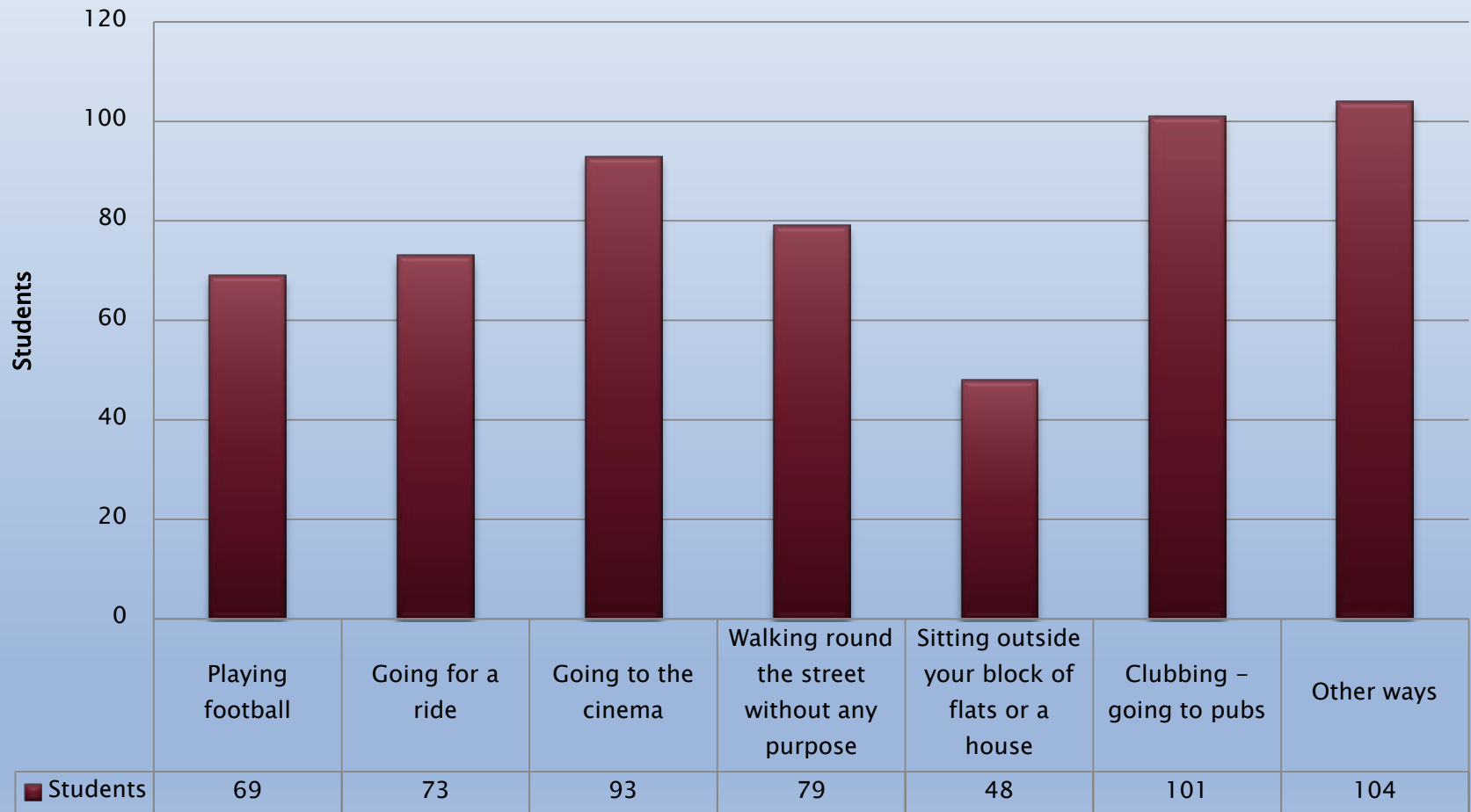

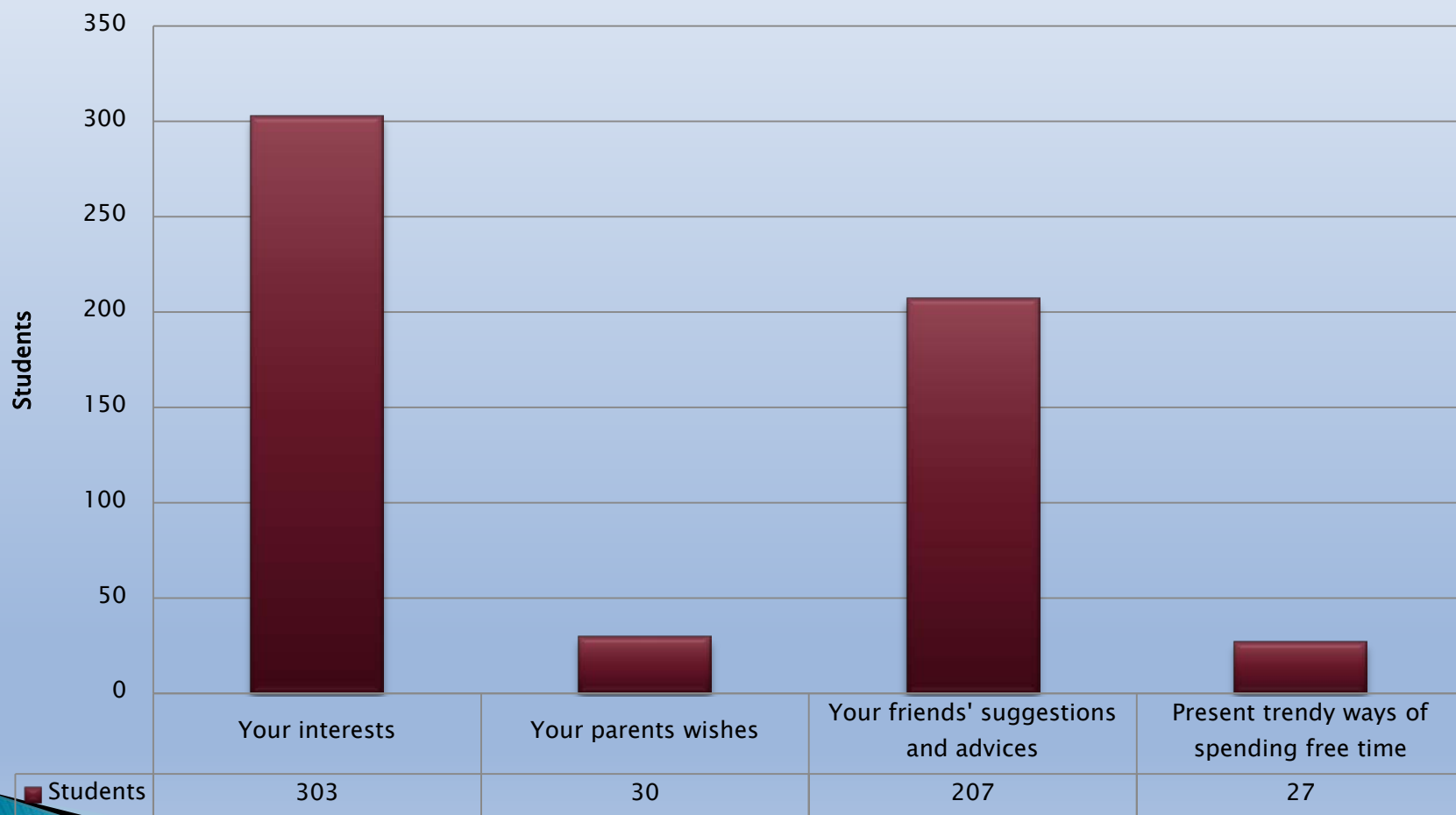

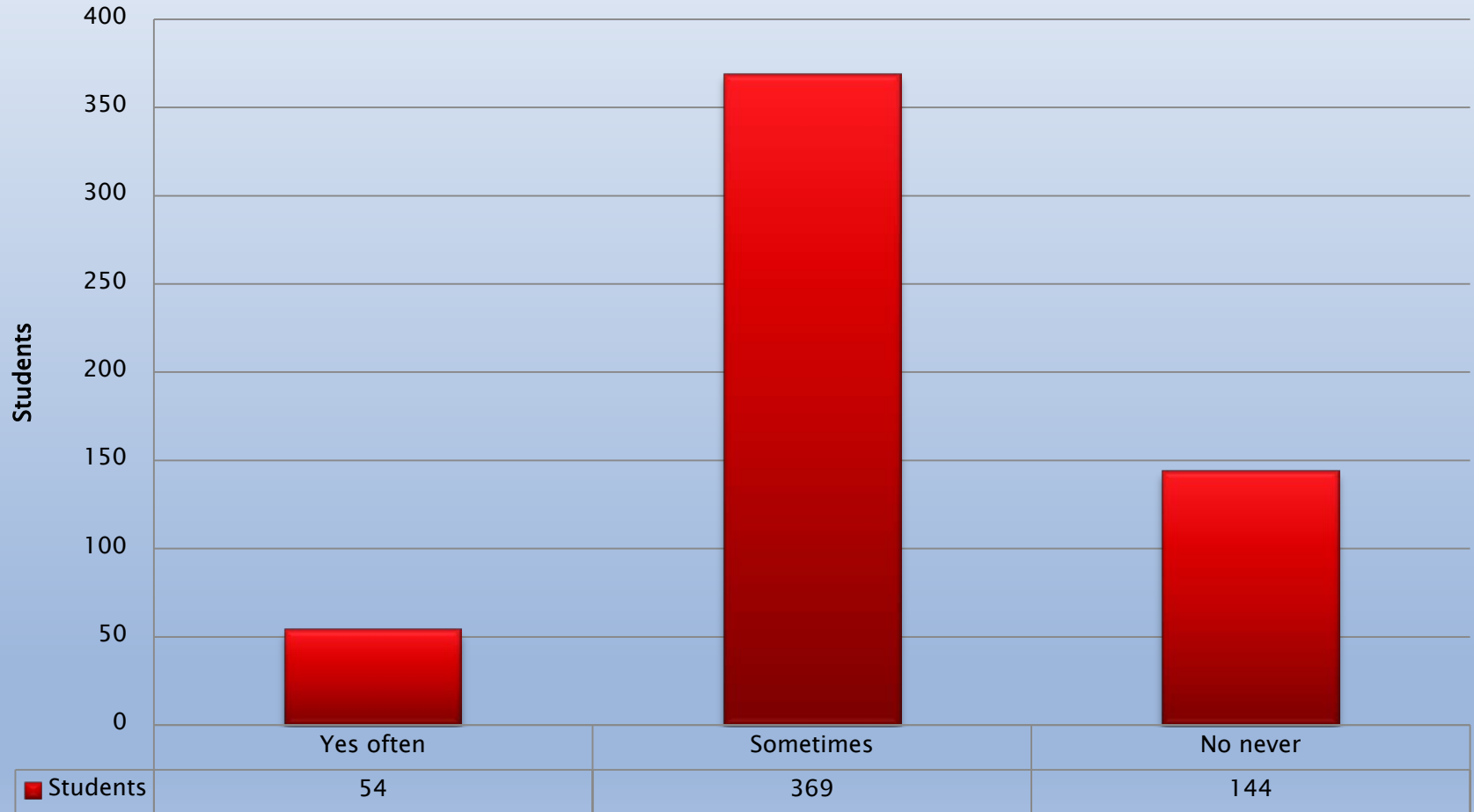

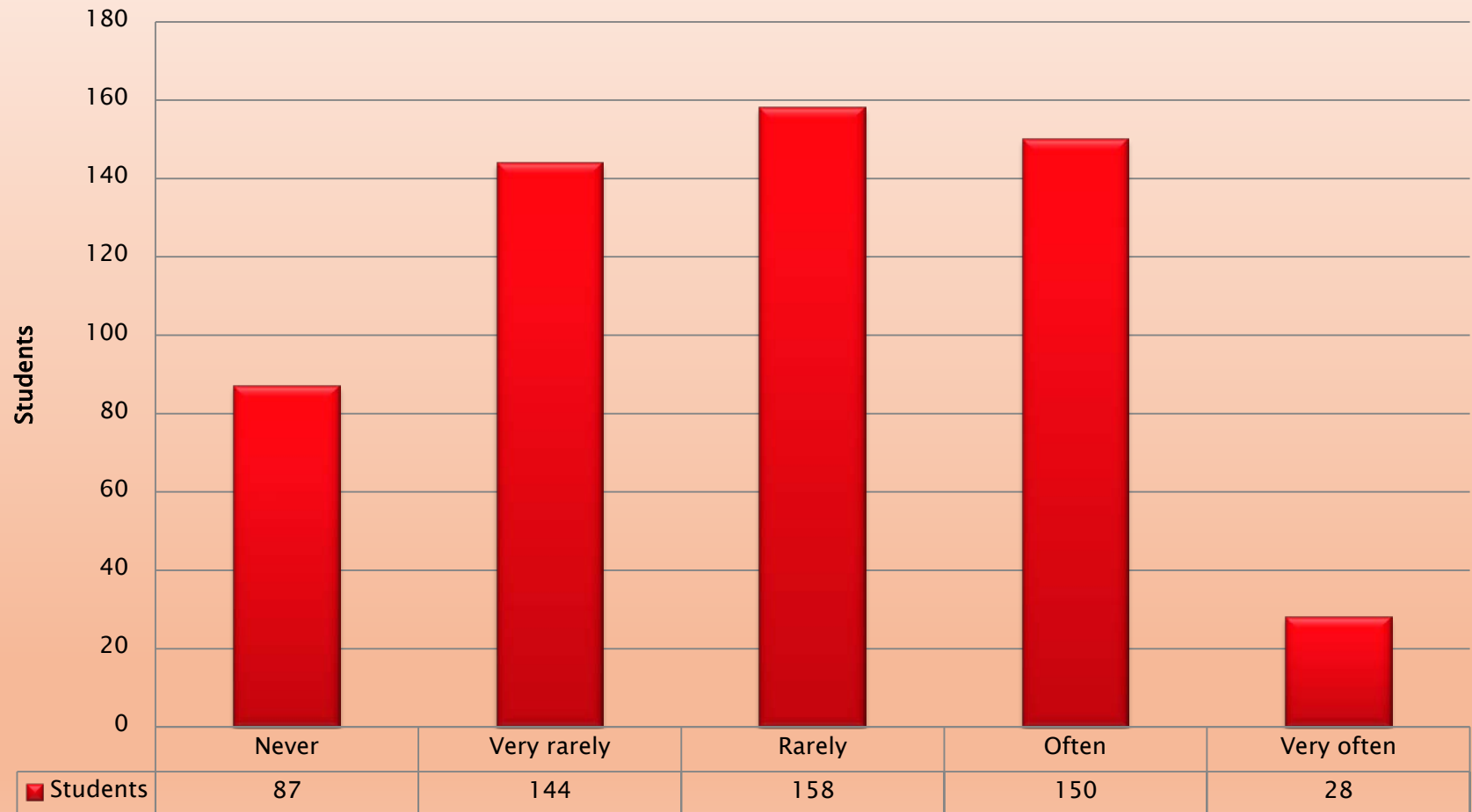
